# DOP's

## Direct Object Pronouns

<b>me</b> - me	<b>nos</b> - us
<b>te</b> - you	<b>os</b> - you all
<b>lo</b> -him/it/you	<b>los/las</b> – them/you all
<b>la</b> - her/it/you	

A Direct Object...  
 Is the recipient of verb (who or what was "verbed")  
 can be found after the verb in English

Example: Are you boarding the plane?  
 ¿Abordas el avión?  
 What is being boarded? → the plane

Direct Object Pronoun = replaces the direct object  
 \*\* agrees m/f & s/p with direct object  
 \*\* goes B-E-F-O-R-E the conjugated verb OR attached to the infinitive  
 Example: Yes, I am boarding it. / I am going to board **it**.  
 Sí, **lo** abordo / Voy a abordarlo. or **Lo** voy a abordar.  
 \*\* It = the plane → el avión (m/s) → **lo**



<b>me</b> – to/for me	<b>nos</b> – to/for us
<b>te</b> – to/for you	<b>os</b> – to/for you all
<b>le</b> – to/for you/him/her	<b>les</b> – to/for you all/them

An Indirect Object...  
 Answers the question "to/for whom/what" about the verb  
 Look for the personal a in Spanish

An Indirect Object Pronoun...  
 Is REQUIRED in Spanish, even if redundant!  
 Accompanies the indirect object  
 Goes B-E-F-O-R-E the conjugated verb or attached to the infinitive  
 Example: Are you giving Juan your ticket?  
 ¿Le das tu boleto a Juan?  
 For whom is the ticket? → Juan
